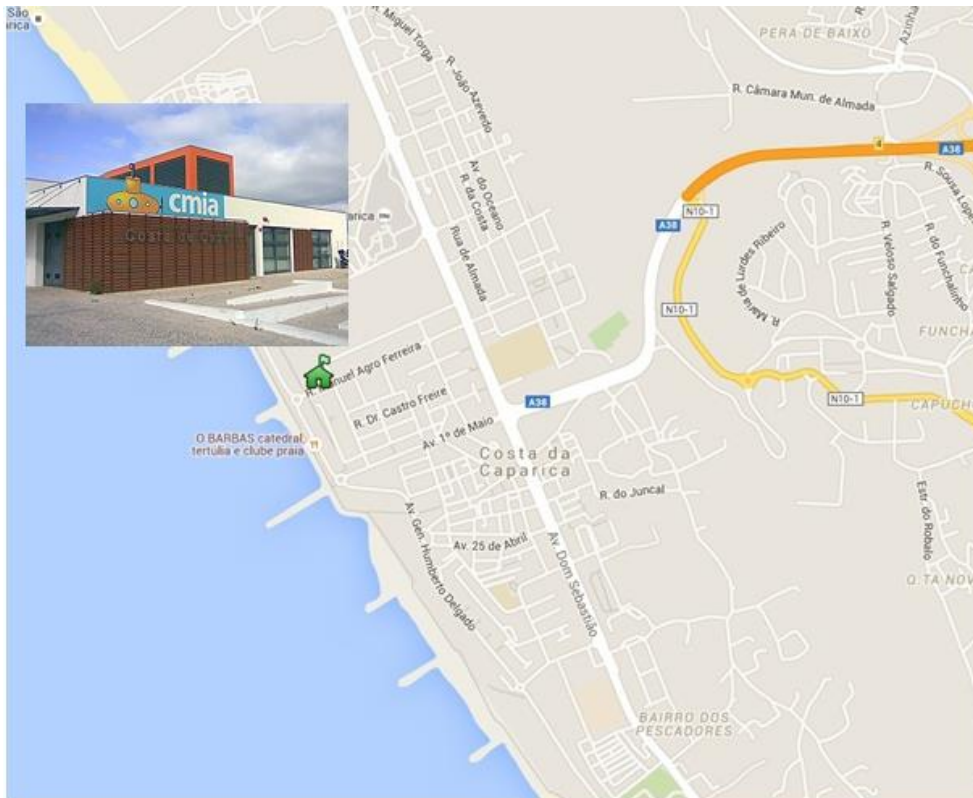

Getting from the airport to the venue:

By taxi (faster, simpler):

Taxi from the airport, costs approximately 25 – 30 € and takes about 30 minutes (on rush hour it can go up to 1 hour)

Suggestion: Take a taxi from the departures section of the airport easily accessible from the arrivals hall. It should be faster and safer.

By public transit:

Option 1

1. Take **Aerobus 1 – City Center** to the stop: Campo Pequeno
2. Take **TST bus 161** from Lisboa-Areeiro to Costa da Caparica, and leave at the last stop
3. Walk 15 minutes to get to the destination

Costs: 6,5€ approximately

Approximate Time: 1h30

Option 2

1. Take the **metro** to Praça de Espanha (take the red line and change at São Sebastião stop to the blue line - direction Amadora - Este)
2. Take **TST bus 153** from Praça de Espanha to Costa da Caparica, and leave at the last stop
3. Walk 15 minutes to get to the destination

Costs: 5€ approximately

Approximate Time: 1h45

Getting from Lisbon city:

By taxi :

Taxi from the city center, costs approximately 20€ and takes about 30 minutes (on rush hour it can go up to 1 hour)

By public transit:

Option 1

1. Take **TST bus 153** (from [Praça de Espanha](#)) or **161** (from [Areeiro](#)) to Costa da Caparica and leave at the last stop.
2. Walk 15 minutes to get to the destination

Costs: 3,25€ approximately

Approximate Time: 1h00

Option 2

1. Take **Fertagus train** from [Areeiro](#), [Entrecampos](#) or [Sete Rios](#) rail stations, to [Pragal](#) rail station.
3. Take **TST bus 124 or 194** to Costa da Caparica and leave at the last stop.
2. Walk 15 minutes to get to the destination

Costs: 5,10€ approximately

Approximate Time: 1h00~1h15
